Soccer Booster Club Scholarship Requirements

1] A total of 500 points must be accumulated by the Spring of a player's senior year to be eligible for a Soccer Booster Club Scholarship. Up to four scholarships of \$250.00 each will be provided. Two scholarships will be provided for each of the Girls and Boys programs. The number and value of the scholarships will be voted on yearly by the Booster Club Trustees. Points are earned in the following ways.

- A. 20 points for each full shift worked by a player in the concession stand.
- B. 20 points for each full shift worked by a parent in the concession stand.
- C. 20 points for miscellaneous contributions to support Booster Club activities.
- D. 1 point for each candy bar sold.
- E. 20 points for each full shift worked by a player in the Canal Town Booth.
- F. 20 points for each full shift worked by a parent in the Canal Town Booth. This includes setting up and tearing down the booth.
- G. 250 points - President of the Booster Club, Chairperson(s) for the following, Concession Stand and Canal Town Booth.
- H. 125 points - Head coach of summer soccer travel team, Treasurer of Booster Club, Summer Coordinator of travel teams.
- I. 50 points - Chairperson for annual candy sale, Board Member of Booster Club, Assistant coach for summer soccer travel league, Chairperson[s] for annual Mother's Day Flower Sale.

In addition to 500 points the player must show good sportsmanship on the soccer field, play soccer in their senior year and have their varsity coach agree they were a good team player. The player must meet the Dollar for Scholar Committee requirements and agree to all the rules of the committee. The scholarship winners will be chosen from a list of eligible players provided to the Scholarship Committee.
