Ball Size: Size 4 Futsal (U11-U12)
 Size 3 Futsal (U9-U10)

PENALTIES:

Free Kicks All restarts are from the point of infraction and are INDIRECT KICKS unless, in the opinion of the referee a flagrant foul occurs inside the goal area; a PENALTY SHOT may be awarded.

**Yellow/
Red Cards** If a player or coach receives a yellow card, the team will play down for two minutes/or until a goal is scored, whichever comes first. If a player or coach receives two yellow cards during the same division, it will be considered a red card and they will be ejected from the remainder of that division. All direct red cards are considered to be an ejection from the entire tournament.

Ejections Players or coaches ejected (straight red card) from the game will be banned from the remainder of the tournament.

TIME: All games will be 20 minutes.

SUBSTITUTIONS: May be made on all dead balls and on the fly, but can only be made when the player coming out is within the bench area.

GOALKEEPERS:

The keeper's area is marked off with tape.

The keeper has seven seconds to release the ball.

Once the keeper places the ball on the ground, he may not pick it up again until the ball is touched by an opposing player. No drop kicks.
Keeper can kick or throw the ball, but it must hit the floor, walls, or a player before the ball crosses half court entering the opposing side. (U9/U10 only)
The Keeper can pick up the ball as long as they have one foot in the box.

OUT OF BOUNDS:

Any ball that hits the ceiling.
There are no throw-ins, all restarts are kick-ins.
Any ball that hits a basketball backboard or frame.
A ball that runs over any line (U11/U12)
Any ball that runs over the line closest to the bleachers. (U9/U10)
All balls above the blue mats. (U9/U10)

SCORING:

3 points for a win.
1 point for a 3+ goal differential
1 point for a tie.
1 point for a shut-out.
-1 point for a win with a goal differential of more than 6 points

In case of a tie in seeding points

- 1) Head to Head (group play)
- 2) Goals Against
- 3) Goals For
- 4) 5 Minute Sudden Victory Mini Game if it decides whether a team makes the playoffs.
- 5) If it is between two teams qualified for the playoffs and it is strictly for seeding, then a coin flip.

In case of a tie in the play-off rounds, there will be an overtime period with the Golden Goal Rule in effect. After each minute, one player from each team will be removed from the court until two versus two is left. Once two vs. two occurs, the clock will be stopped and the first team to score wins. There are unlimited substitutions during the overtimes. Each team must have an identifiable goalie.

These rules are subject to modifications prior to the tournament.
